Gumtz called for nominations for Assistant Clerk, Seubert nominated Knoeck, no other nominations; Motion by Seubert 2nd by Klumpyan to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Knoeck for Assistant Clerk. Motion carried.

Motion by Knoeck, 2nd by Seubert to go into closed session pursuant to State Statute 19.85(1)(c) and (e) and (f) and 118.22(3) for the purpose of considering employment, or performance of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or excercises responsibility.
