Motion by Vesely, 2nd by Seubert to approve designation of School District Legal counsel and maintain current counsel, Dean Dietrich, as he joined the law firm of Weld Riley, S.C. Yes – DeBroux, Knoeck, Klumpyan, Seubert, and Vesely. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Vesely, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Klumpyan to adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:49 AM.
