Motion by Knoeck, 2nd by Seubert to approve the hire of Jay Schmidt as MHS Math Teacher with a mentor and CESA support plan. Yes - Klumpyan, Knoeck, Seubert, Vesely, and DeBroux. Motion carried 5-0

DeBroux exited the meeting and turned the meeting over to Vice-President Klumpyan at 8:49 am.

The Board discussed overload scheduling and compensation and how it impacts staff along with the exit interview process. The Board asked Mr. Parks to bring back comparisons of overload pay from surrounding districts.
