**PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AT RISK**

The Board shall establish programs to serve children in the district who are identified at risk. "Children at risk" are students who are at risk of not graduating from high school. All programs developed for children at risk shall be designed to:

- a. Improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis, through a variety of means (e.g., remedial instruction);
- b. Provide alternative courses or program modifications that satisfactorily meet district graduation requirements;
- c. Encourage parental involvement; and,
- d. Encourage cooperation with community support service agencies.

Students shall be identified and referred to these programs in accordance with state regulations and guidelines established by the administration. An annual report concerning children at risk shall be made to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction if required by law.
