

GRADING SYSTEMS

The district shall evaluate student achievement in grades kindergarten through 12. The issuance of grades on a regular basis serves to:

1. Promote a process of continuous evaluation of student performance;
2. Inform the student and his/her parent/guardian of the student's progress; and
3. Provide a basis for bringing about change in student performance if such change is deemed necessary.

The Marathon City School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
