

**TESTING PROGRAMS**

The testing program in the Marathon City School District shall be designed to yield information on student achievement and study ability. Professional staff are expected to use the test results as an aid in the evaluation of individual students and instructional programs designed to ensure student success in the home, school, community and as citizens in our democratic nation.

Test results shall be reported to the Department of Public Instruction (DPI), parents/guardians and to the public in accordance with law.

The district testing program shall embody those tests required by state laws and regulations.

Decisions regarding the testing of students with disabilities and limited-English proficient (LEP) students shall be made on an individual basis in accordance with district policies and procedures.

The Marathon City School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for testing and evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
