

**INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION**

The Board is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the district. The responsibility for the selection of instructional materials, however, is delegated to the professionally trained certified personnel of the district.

Selection of materials may involve instructional media specialists, principals, teachers, students, administrators and community persons. The selection and purchase of instructional materials shall be the responsibility of the certified library/media personnel, teachers and principals.

Specific selection procedures shall be developed for use in the district.

The Marathon City School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
