

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY PROGRAM

An extracurricular activities program shall be offered to students in the schools in the district. Participants in extracurricular activities shall comply with established school and activity rules. Students who violate school and/or activity rules shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The administration shall assign advisors for the supervision of all extracurricular activities.

The Board encourages the full participation of elementary, middle and high school students in extracurricular and recreational programs and activities. For purposes of Board policy, "full participation" means fair and equal participation to the extent that the budget, facilities or type of activity allows.

All extracurricular and athletic practices and events shall be scheduled and canceled in accordance with the following:

- Performance events for high school and elementary students may be held on a Saturday or Sunday if necessitated by policies and practices of organizations outside of the district's jurisdiction or if no other date is available.
- Practices are not to be scheduled for a Saturday, unless a school cancellation has caused a practice to be canceled during the preceding week. Saturday practices may also be scheduled for a team participating in tournaments or competitions sanctioned by the governing body for the activity, such as the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA), (FFA), Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) etc.
- Practices for high school students may be held on a Saturday (8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.) or a Sunday (but not both) between the hours of 12:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m., if there is an event scheduled for the following Monday or Tuesday. Practices are limited to two hours during this time, and will be coordinated to avoid conflicts with other sports and extra-curricular activities. Exemptions to this rule may be granted by the school board upon written request.
- Practices for elementary or middle school teams may not be held on a Sunday. In addition, practices for elementary and middle school students, when held on school nights, must conclude by 8:00 p.m.
- On Wednesdays, all practices shall be completed and participants shall have left the practice area by 6:15 p.m.
- If school is canceled for any reason, there shall be no extracurricular practices or events held on that day. At the discretion of the administration, practices or events may be held.

The Marathon City School District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
