SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

It shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian of each child or a student of legal age entering the Marathon City School District to complete official registration form prior to assignment by the principal to a grade or schedule of classes.

The Board shall not enroll a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another school district.

Students transferring from another public school system, a private school or a home-based private educational program are required to provide a transcript of academic accomplishments at the previous school or program or the address from which this data may be secured. Should the records be unavailable or found to be incomplete or inadequate to develop a recommendation for an educational program or placement, a placement examination shall be administered to the student.

Parents/guardians of students admitted to the district's elementary and secondary schools shall present immunization records as required by law. In addition: (a) students are encouraged to have a complete physical examination prior to entering school; and, (b) each student entering kindergarten is asked to provide evidence that the child has had his/her eyes examined by a licensed optometrist or evaluated by a licensed physician. Students complying with this request must provide evidence of an eye examination or evaluation in accordance with the timeline established in state law.

The Marathon City School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
