

PRIVACY IN LOCKER ROOMS

Under no circumstances may electronic devices with photographic capabilities, including cell phone, recording devices, motion pictures or other means, be used in locations where there is an expectation of privacy, such as locker rooms or bathrooms.

School locker rooms are segregated for female or male occupancy. All personnel will observe this proper posted distinction when entering these facilities. This prohibition does not apply if the person is a school district appointed coach/supervisor of a sports team, club, or intramural organization performing his/her respective assigned duties, i.e., coaches, athletic trainers or other such assigned school personnel.

People wishing to locate, interview or seek information from any individual in the locker room, must seek permission from the adult in charge of the sports team, club, or school district organization prior to entering and/or remaining in the locker room.
