

EMPLOYEES' RIGHT TO KNOW

In accordance with state law, employees are able to request and obtain information from the district on toxic substances, infectious agents and pesticides present in the workplace. Information available includes:

1. The identity of any toxic substances and infectious agents employees work with or are likely to come into contact with or have been exposed to.
2. A description of the hazardous effects of the toxic substances and infectious agents.
3. Handling precautions for toxic substances and infectious agents.
4. Procedures for emergency treatment in the event of over-exposure. District employees might find toxic substances in laboratories, custodial work and storage areas, shop areas, art rooms and school offices. This list is not all inclusive. Toxic substances may be found in other locations as well.
5. Procedures for gaining access to the information contained on the label of any pesticides with which the employee works or to which the employee is likely to be exposed.
