

CRISIS INTERVENTION PLAN

The purpose of a crisis intervention plan is to provide school staff and appropriate community personnel, including interested media, with information needed in order to carry out a coordinated effort in the event of a crisis. A crisis may include an attempted or completed suicide, natural death, accident or other crisis situation involving a student or staff member which may prompt the crisis team to implement parts or all of the plan.

It is felt that through the use of a crisis team consisting of specific staff members and community people and a well-developed written plan, appropriate measures will be used in the event of a crisis. These measures will allow for the family's/families' rights, accurate dissemination of information, appropriate intervention activities at school and identification of students and staff requiring further intervention in dealing with the crisis.
