

**Marathon Wellness Center  
Use of Wellness Center Facility**

The Marathon Wellness Center (MWC) was conceived to meet the health and fitness needs of the School District of Marathon City students, staff and residents. The MWC is a facility designed to enhance the well being of all residents of the School District of Marathon City.

Access to the MWC is meant to be convenient to students, staff, and residents of the district. Safety is the top priority in establishing rules and regulations for use of the facility.

The Marathon Board of Education will establish the fees for use of the facility.

The Marathon Board of Education is responsible for establishing the hours of operation, distinguishing between student priority hours and community only hours.

The Marathon Board of Education is responsible for determining the supervision provisions of the MWC.

The Marathon Board of Education is responsible for establishing the minimum age of MWC participants.

The Marathon Board of Education is responsible for establishing all rules and regulations for use of the MWC.
