Marathon High School Post Prom Event Policy

Attendance Policy:

- All Marathon High School (MHS) students are invited to attend the Post Prom Party whether or not they attend Prom.
- Post Prom will run from 11:30 2:30
- Any student on suspension or expulsion is not allowed to attend Post Prom.
- Registration will be open only from 11p.m.-12a.m.
- Registration closes at 12 a.m. no student admission afterwards.
- Parents of students who turned in signed permission/waiver forms, but who DO NOT register by 12 a.m. will be contacted by phone.
- Each MHS student is allowed to bring one guest. (check with Main Office for requirements.)
- All student attendees and guests 18 and under must have a signed parent/guardian permission/waiver form and provide two valid phone numbers on file at MHS in order to attend Post Prom.
- All students must check in at the Post Prom Party registration tables to receive an ID bracelet/tickets.
- Students and guests are required to wear the provided ID bracelet while at the Post Prom Party.
- There will be zero tolerance for alcoholic beverages or drugs on the premises, this includes cigarettes.
- If a student appears intoxicated upon arrival, the student's parents will be contacted and asked to pick up the student immediately.
- Purses, handbags, backpacks, etc. will be subject to search.
- Carry-ins of any kind will not be allowed; this includes water bottles.
- The dress code is Prom attire or casual clothes. *Students are awarded tickets for wearing Prom Attire.
- Students who wish to change clothes for the Post Prom Party must do so before checking in at the registration table. Be sure to come prepared w/change of clothes. Students will be responsible for storing prom attire offsite. There are no arrangements to safeguard prom clothes, handbags or personal belongings.
- Only MHS students are eligible for gifts and prizes. Students must be <u>present</u> to win.
- Respect is expected for entertainment staff, committee members, volunteers, facility personnel, equipment and facility property.
- Students are expected to refrain from foul language, harassment and excessive horseplay.
- Zero tolerance for fighting. If a student is involved in a fight, their parents will be phoned and asked to pick up the student immediately.
- Tickets will not be sold at the door; no last minute exceptions.

Departure Policy:

- Any student who wishes to leave Post Prom early (before 2:30 a.m.) must sign out with a security volunteer after their parent/guardian has been informed.
- Any student who chooses to leave the party early will not be allowed to return & is not eligible for any prizes.
- Parents of students who are under age 18 will be phoned at the contact number provided and informed of the student's departure prior to having them sign out.

Chaperone Policy:

- All party chaperones must wear pre-printed name tags.
- All party chaperones will refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages prior to or during the event and will refrain from smoking on the facility property.
- It is the responsibility of all chaperones to safeguard students. If a student appears intoxicated upon arrival, call his or her parents and request the parent to pick up the student immediately.
- It is the responsibility of all chaperones to watch for containers in which students might conceal alcohol or drugs.
