Course Tuition

The Marathon School District will provide the necessary cost of the course, providing the student completes the course with a passing grade. *If a student fails the course, the student/parent will be responsible for the cost of the course and materials.*

In the event the student does not complete the course for any reason, the student/parent is responsible for the cost of the course and materials.

Grades

Whenever the Marathon School District pays the tuition cost for a student, the resulting course grade and credit will be entered on both the high school and postsecondary school records. In the event the student withdraws from the course and a grade is given from the host institution, the grade and credit will be entered on both high school and post-secondary school records.

Textbooks

The Marathon School District will provide the necessary cost of the textbook required if the textbook is reusable. The textbook is the property of the school district. After the student is finished using the book, it will be returned to the school district.

If the textbook is a combination textbook and workbook, it is considered non-reusable and the student/parent shall pay for the book. It then becomes the property of the student.

Apprenticeship Programs.

In addition to the above guidelines, if a student completes a technical college course and then decides to drop out of an apprenticeship program mid-year, the student/parent is responsible for the cost of the current course.
