1. As you complete your course selection form, see the Course Planning Guide in Schoology or on the high school website for course descriptions needed.
2. **English** – Select English 9
3. **Mathematics** - Select your next level of math.  
The sequence:
  - Pre-Algebra
  - Algebra I
  - Geometry
  - Algebra II
  - AP Precalculus
  - AP Calculus AB
  - Statistics (available 10-12th grade - one half credit)
4. **Science** – Select General Science
5. **Social Studies** – Select US History Great Wars & US History Superpowers.
6. **Physical Education** – Select Physical Education 9
7. **Health** – Select Health.
8. **Electives** - Select additional courses to complete your course list for next year.  
Remember the maximum amount of credits is 7.0 (no study hall). If you would like a study hall both semesters of next year, make sure your total number of credits for next year is 6.0. Study halls will be added automatically if you register for less than 7.0 credits.
