ACT Testing – 11th Grade

Juniors will be taking the ACT +Writing on Tuesday, March 19 at Marathon High School. The test begins at 8:00 AM.

Students receiving test accommodations will begin testing on Tuesday, March 12. Communication has been sent home to parents/guardians.

This year's test will be taken using the student's school issued Chromebook (personal devices are not allowed).

All juniors must arrive at school on March 19 by 7:50AM with a charged Chromebook, their charger & an ACT approved calculator.

Testing will last approximately 4 hours and upon completion, students will be provided with a lunch before returning to their afternoon classes.

Juniors have pre-registered for the ACT and had the option to select up to 4 schools to send their test scores to for Free. Please discuss this with your child and have them access their MyACT account to show you their profile and school choices.

What's Not Allowed for Testing!

Advanced Placement Exams

Students currently enrolled in spring semester AP Government have the option to sign up for & take the AP test on May 6, 2024.

Registration form and payment are due to Ms. Aune no later than March 8, 2024.

PRE-ACT - 9th & 10th Grade

All 9th and 10th grade students will take the Pre-ACT Secure on Tuesday, March 19 beginning at 8:00AM at Marathon High School. Students requiring testing accommodations will also begin testing on March 19.

The Pre-ACT is an online assessment using the student's school-issued Chromebook. Students will complete tests in English, Reading, Math and Science.

All 9th & 10th grade students must arrive at school on March 19 no later than 7:50 AM with a charged Chromebook, their Chromebook charger & an ACT approved calculator.

Testing will last 2 hours and 35 minutes and upon completion of the test, students will return to their normally scheduled classes.
