Artist Participation Guidelines

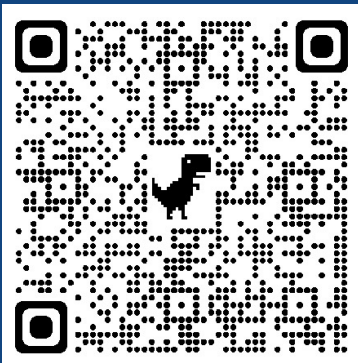
The Healing Minds & HeARTs SHOW is open to residents of Marathon, Lincoln & Langlade Counties in WI that:
