- 1. As you complete your course selection form, see the Course Planning Guide in Schoology or on the high school website for course descriptions needed.
- 2. **English** Select English 10
- Mathematics Select your next level of math.

- 4. **Science** Select Biology

If you successfully completed Algebra, you may select Chemistry as an additional elective.

- 5. **Social Studies** Select a Social Studies elective.
- 6. **Physical Education** Select either Lifetime Fitness or Advanced Strength. You must successfully complete Physical Education 9 before selecting another Phy Ed course.
- 7. <u>Health</u> Health is a required course. If you do not successfully complete the course in 9th grade, you must retake as a sophomore.
- 8. <u>Electives</u> Select additional courses to complete your course list for next year. Remember the maximum amount of credits is 7.0 (no study hall). If you would like a study hall both semesters of next year, make sure your total number of credits for next year is 6.0. Study halls will be added automatically if you register for less than 7.0 credits.
