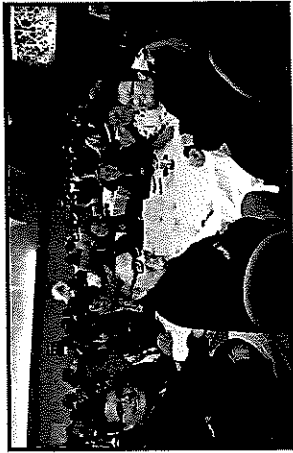

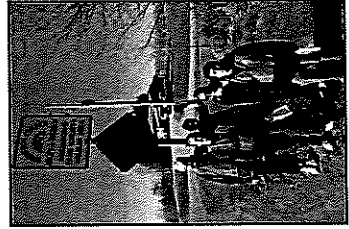
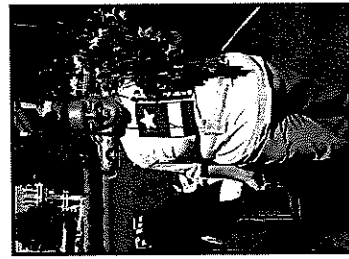

Benefits 2021'22

Full-time members serve 1,700 hours and will receive \$17,000.00 (max.) distributed bi-weekly throughout the 12 months of service. Upon completion, members will also receive an Education Award of \$6,345.00 Health Insurance benefit eligible.

Reduced full-time members serve 1,200 hours and will receive \$12,000.00 (max.) distributed bi-weekly throughout the 9.5 months of service (academic year). Upon completion, members will also receive an Education Award of \$4,441.50 Health Insurance benefit eligible.

Half-time members serve 900 hours and will receive \$8,100.00 (max.) distributed bi-weekly throughout the 12 months of service. Upon completion, members will also receive an Education Award of \$3,172.50

Summer Minimum-time members serve 300 hours and will receive \$3,000.00 (max.) distributed bi-weekly throughout the 11 weeks of service; 5/30-8/13/2022. Upon completion, members will also receive an Education Award of \$1,342.86
