

Written notice of the regular meeting was posted and sent to the news media on Thursday, May 7, 2020, with notice of the Public Hearing posted on Thursday, April 23, 2020.

Information pertaining to the Resolution for the Waiver of instructional hours for students for the 2019-2020 school year due to the public health emergency was reviewed.

Motion by Knoeck, 2nd by DeBroux to approve the School Board Resolution for the Waiver of Certain School Board or School District Requirements Pursuant to WIS. STAT. 118.38(1) AND (1m) as they relate to the COVID-19 pandemic and closure of public schools. And, to approve Waiver of the requirements of Wis. Stat. 121.02(1)(f) and the administrative rules promulgated by the department regarding required instructional hours for students for the 2019-2020 school year only due to the COVID-19 public health emergency. Yes - DeBroux, Klumpyan, Knoeck, Seubert, and Gumtz. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Seubert, 2nd by DeBroux to adjourn the Public Hearing and proceed with the regular scheduled meeting. Motion carried 5-0. Hearing adjourned at 5:34
