

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The constitution of the State of Wisconsin is the legal basis for the establishment of the Board of Education for the Marathon City School District. The state statutes pertaining to education allow the community to operate schools and authorize the citizens to elect representatives to govern the schools.

The Board of Education shall consist of five members. The Board of Education membership shall be selected by the electorate at the regular spring election following the procedure outlined for such election by the state statutes.
