

**BOARD MEMBER DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

The Board believes that inservice training for its members is vital in order for the Board to govern the district in the most informed and prudent manner possible. Informed decisionmaking grows more important as school governance becomes increasingly complex.

In keeping with this position, the Board encourages the participation of its members at appropriate school board conferences, conventions, seminars and workshops. Members wishing to attend shall ask the district administrator to place the request on the board's agenda for approval at the next scheduled board meeting. The District shall pay any attendance fee and shall reimburse attending Board members for travel expenses, as well as other necessary expenses, in accordance with policies established by the electorate at the Annual Meeting.

Annually, the Board shall select one of its members to represent the district at the Wisconsin Association of School Boards (WASB) Delegate Assembly. Whenever a new delegate is chosen by the Board, that individual shall be certified in writing to the WASB.
