

**STUDENT ENROLLMENT ACCOUNTING**

Students in the Marathon City School District shall be considered full-time if they can be classified into at least one of the following categories:

1. A student in grades kindergarten through eight who is scheduled for the full day of study.
2. A student in grades nine through 12 who is carrying a minimum of five full-time classes per semester.
3. A student with disabilities who has been assessed by an individualized education program (IEP) team and has been prescribed a program.
4. A student receiving homebound instruction or a special program as approved by the student's parent/guardian and school officials (i.e., children at risk program, school-age parent program).
5. A district resident attending a school in another public school district on a full-time basis under the state's public school open enrollment program.
6. Students enrolled or participating in any alternative educational programs that includes children at risk, truants, and school-age parents.
7. Students who are excused from school attendance to participate in a program leading to high school graduation or a high school equivalency diploma.
