

SHARED PROGRAMMING

Students who reside in the school district and are enrolled in a non-public school or home-based private educational program may take courses at the high school in accordance with state law and may participate in federally funded services in accordance with federal law.

Students who reside in the district and are enrolled in a non-public school or home-based private educational program may, upon written request, participate in the school's competency testing program and system-wide achievement testing. A \$10 fee shall be charged for each test administered. Testing is to occur at school at the same time as the student's peer group is tested. It is the parent(s)/guardian(s) responsibility to request test dates and places from the building principal.

Except for students who are taking courses or participating in services as specified above, instructional materials may not be loaned to students enrolled in a home-based private educational program.

When the Marathon City School District is notified of a home-based program for a resident student, a copy of this policy shall be mailed to the home for informational purposes.
