STUDENT DRESS

Responsibility for the appearance of students enrolled in the Marathon City School District shall normally rest with the parents/guardians and the students themselves. They have the right to determine student dress provided such attire complies with health and safety codes and does not interfere with the educational process.

When a student's attire disrupts the educational process or causes a health or safety problem, he/she may be referred to the building principal for possible action.

Physical Education Attire

All students participating in a physical education class must wear a district-approved uniform and proper footwear. Accommodations shall be made for students who have an objection to the uniform requirement on the basis of their religious beliefs.

Uniforms may be purchased, at cost, through the building office. Students qualifying to receive free or reduced price meals shall be provided a uniform at no charge.
