EMERGENCY NURSING SERVICES

Emergency nursing services, including first aid services, shall be provided by the district and shall be available during the school day and at all school-sponsored activities in accordance with state law. The district shall contract with a certified physician to supervise the emergency nursing services, to serve as medical advisor.

A designated health area shall be available in each school that is equipped with the supplies necessary to provide emergency care in accordance with standards set by the Department of Public Instruction and the Department of Health and Family Services.

Procedures for dealing with accidental injury, illness and medication shall be established. These procedures shall be reviewed annually with the instructional staff, including all athletic coaches.

A record system shall be maintained in the district, including accident reports and a log of services performed. Confidentiality standards shall be maintained in accordance with state and federal laws and regulations.

Emergency nursing services shall be reviewed annually by the Board.
