STUDENT IMMUNIZATIONS

All students admitted to the Marathon City School District must present immunization records as required by law. Except as otherwise provided, immunizations shall be required for measles, rubella, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), poliomyelitis, tetanus, mumps and other diseases as required by the Department of Health and Family Services.

A student may be waived from the immunization requirement when the student, if an adult, or the student's parent/guardian or legal custodian submits a written statement objecting to the immunization for reasons of health, religion or personal conviction.

In cooperation with public health agencies and officials, the Board shall develop and implement a plan to encourage compliance with state student immunization requirements. The plan shall be submitted to the appropriate state agency as required by law.

It shall be the responsibility of the District Administrator, in cooperation with the Marathon County Nursing Service to ensure the district is in compliance with the requirements of state law.
