Mask Use



In certain situations/areas of the buildings and at certain grade levels, masks and/or face shields will be required by students and staff. All staff will be wearing masks or face shields when working with students. All students will wear

them when riding the bus and arriving at school. Students in grades 4k-4th grade are encouraged to but will not be required to wear them when in their classroom cohorts. Students in grades 5-12 will wear them for most of their school day. Mask breaks will take place throughout the day.

*We will follow State and County orders when in effect regarding masks. When orders end we may continue with district mask plans.

Lunch

Lunch will be spread out to different locations and in staggered times to reduce the number of students in any one location. To help reduce the amount of students waiting in the lunch line parents are encouraged to pack their own students' lunches when possible.
