

Marathon City School District **Raider Virtual Plan**

In the event of a whole-school shutdown at Marathon School District due to Covid-19 during the 2020-21 school year, students will return to a virtual learning environment.

Review the detailed plan and so that you are prepared

All parents and students are asked to review the [Raider Virtual Plan](#). This plan is a guide to be used in the event of a short term school shutdown (1-2 weeks) or a long term shutdown (over 2 weeks). Currently we do not anticipate a shutdown, but we all know in these uncertain times it is better to be prepared than not.



Internet

We encourage parents to plan in the event that school may get shutdown. Preparation may include testing to see what internet speeds are available to you or checking what options you may have. The district has a limited supply of hot spots to help families out and is seeking to get more, but parents should not rely on this as their primary option. It will be important for families to have a plan in place.



Athletics



All district athletic teams, practices, and competitions will be paused during the period of a full virtual shutdown.

English Learners

Students identified as English Learners may be allowed to attend school to work with teachers and EL supports.

Family Coaches

Support staff will be tasked as family coaches, supporting students and families in the area of technology support, scheduling, and pick-up and drop off of supplies and materials.

Schedules

In the event of a shutdown during the 2020-2021 school year, school will look different than in the Spring of 2020. Lunch

The school district will provide sack breakfasts and lunches for pick-up at each school lobby.



Counseling, Psychologist, and Nursing Services

Special Education

Students in special education may be allowed to attend school in small cohorts to maintain the legal obligations of their IEP's as well as for those who are medically in need of support.

Grading

All grading practices will be the same as if the students were in school. Assignments must be on time, and quizzes and tests must be taken at the time they are provided. Students will also have the same requirements for promotion and graduation.
