Yearbook Senior Photo Submission Rules

- 1. Dress code: Senior photos must adhere to the school dress code policy. Students should dress in appropriate attire and avoid clothing that displays offensive or inappropriate graphics or messages.
- 2. Face visibility: Senior photos must clearly show the student's face. Photos that obscure the face (such as photos with excessive shadows or lighting) will not be accepted.
- 3. No drugs or alcohol: Senior photos must not depict the use of drugs or alcohol. Photos containing such content will not be accepted.
- 4. No firearms or weapons: Senior photos must not depict firearms, weapons, bows, or other dangerous objects. Photos containing such content will not be accepted.
- 5. Inclusion: All eligible seniors will be included in the yearbook. However, the yearbook staff reserves the right to exclude any photos that do not meet the established guidelines.
- 6. Submission deadline: Senior photos must be submitted by a specified deadline. Late submissions may not be included in the yearbook.
- 7. Photos can not have students with hats on.
- 8. No flags, banners, or shirts with slogans or sayings on them.
- 9. Image quality: Senior photos must be high-quality, digital images with a minimum resolution of 300 DPI. Students should ensure that their photos are properly exposed, in focus, and free of any digital artifacts or distortions.
- 10. Image orientation: Senior photos must be in a portrait orientation. Landscape-oriented photos will not be accepted.
